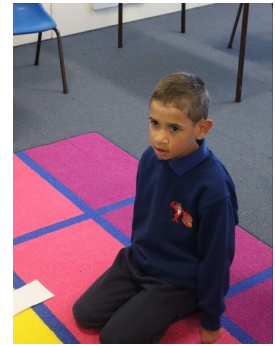

#### Important information

- Front entrance/gate will be open from 8.30-3.00pm every day
- Students are to wear school uniform including a jumper or jacket due to cold weather (at the moment it does not matter if this is not school uniform). Windows in classrooms will be slightly open for increased ventilation
- The school bus will be operating Mondays and Tuesdays
- Back gate will be open from 8.30-9.00 for school drop offs
- Parents are encouraged to stay in their car when dropping off and picking up students at the end of the day
- Back gate will be locked from 9.00-2.55. Please use the front gate during these times and follow the displayed protocols
- Students will be required to sanitise their hands when moving in and out of classrooms. Social distancing (1.5m distance) will be encouraged
- Enhanced school cleaning will be occurring during school hours
- Students will need to have fruit, **PACKED LUNCH** and **RECESS**. We will provide them with a labelled water bottle for use during the day as the bubblers will not be in use
- Limited sport equipment will be available at break times. This will be sanitised after each break. The playground equipment will not be used
- No games involving physical contact are to be played
- **PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD IF THEY ARE SICK OR UNWELL.** Sick children will be sent home
