Culture of Success

Tingha Public School is committed to a 'school culture of learning success'. COVID-19

The Department of Education is communicating with NSW Health only a daily basis to focus its efforts on considered actions to slow the spread of COVID-19. The department has been planning and operating its pandemic plan to support the safety and wellbeing of staff and students.

The three actions which can help manage the spread include:

1. Wash hands regularly and thoroughly with soap and water and avoid touching their eyes, nose, and mouth before washing their hands.
2. Sneezing into your elbow or a tissue, disposing of the tissue straight away and then washing your hands
3. Staying at home if you are unwell. If students become unwell at school they will be sent home.

NAPLAN Online

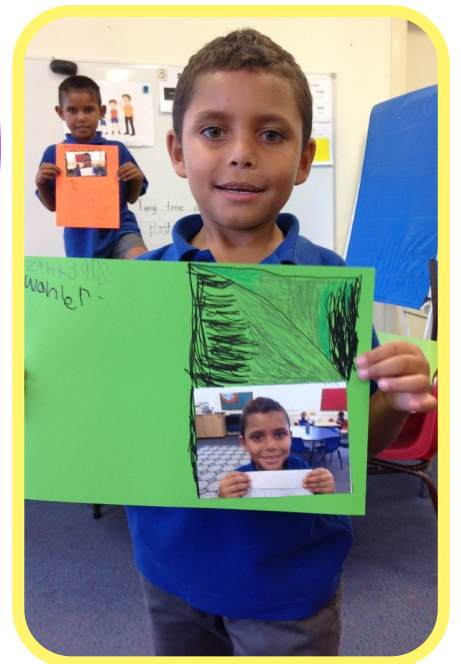
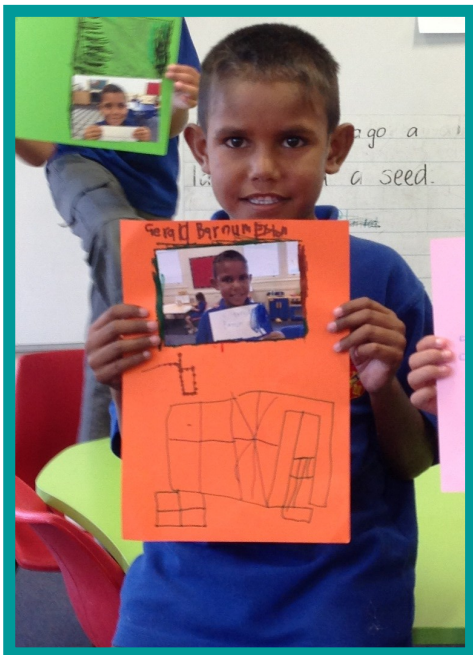

Everyone had the opportunity to assist in the cooking process.



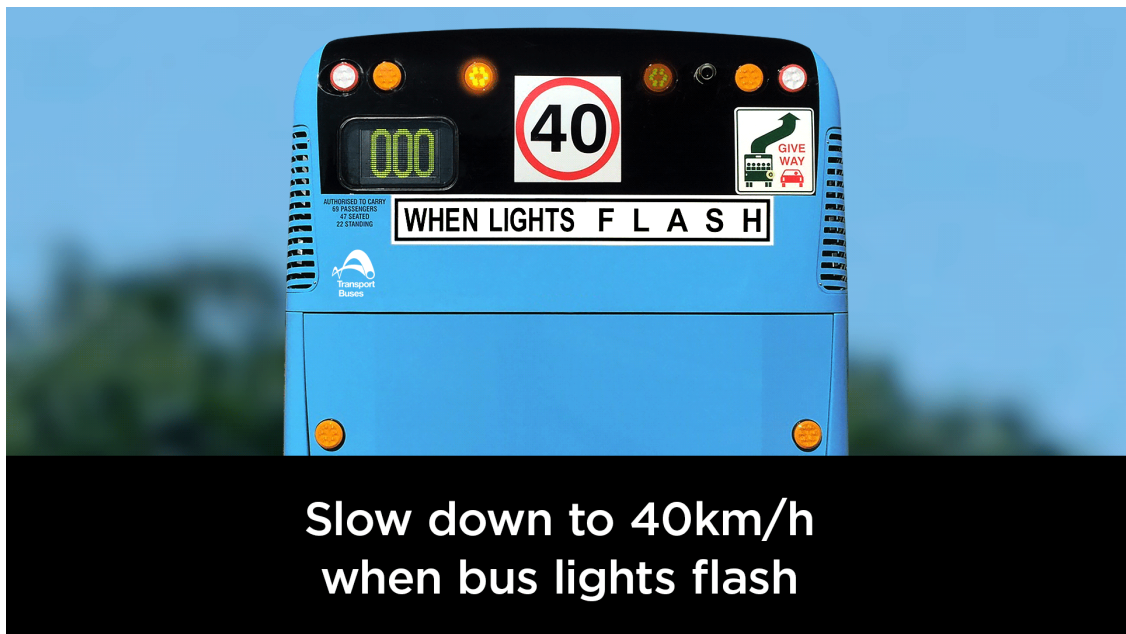
They also had the opportunity to taste what they cooked and share what they cooked with the rest of the school.
