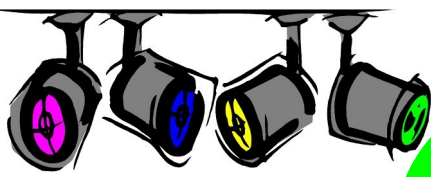
Have Your Say on Before and After School Care

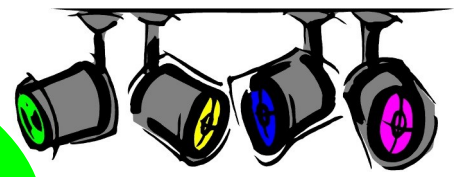

The survey has been designed to be easy to use and should take no more than two minutes to complete, with a few extra minutes for those who would like to supply additional information.

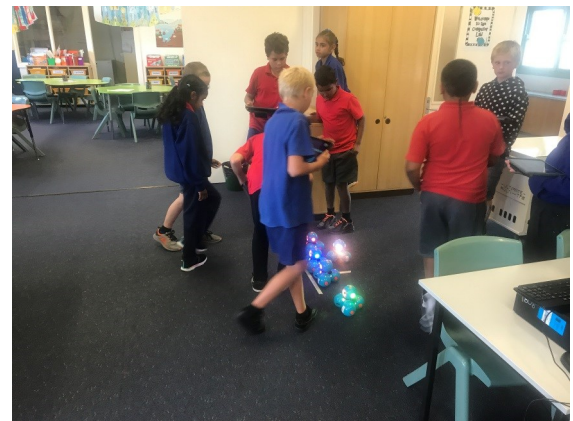

Years 4/5/6 have had a great time using and programming the Dash robots. It has been challenging but students have persisted as you can see in the photos.

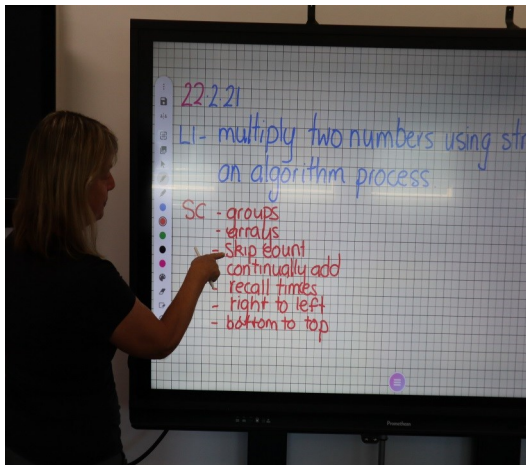


Our days start off with our Literacy Rotations.





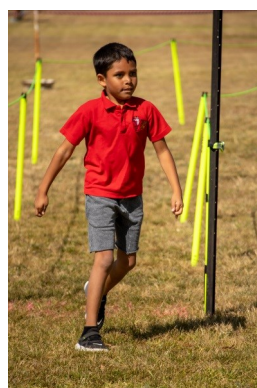
The use of technology, every day, is another way the students engage and consolidate their learning.

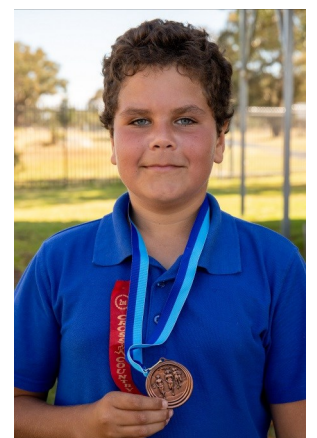
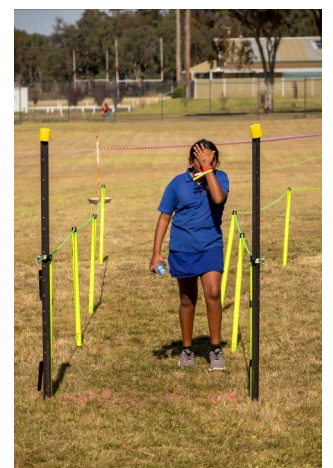
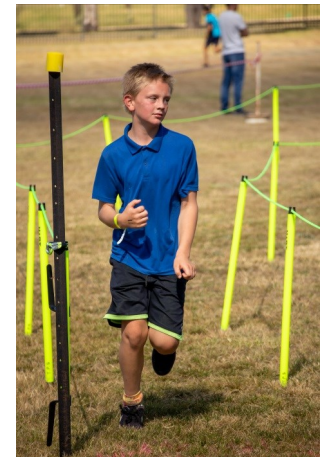


Everyday the students enjoy having a brain break from their learning by participating in either a game of handball, soccer or some relaxing yoga.

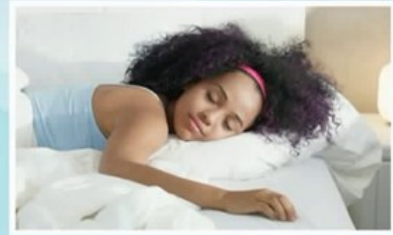
