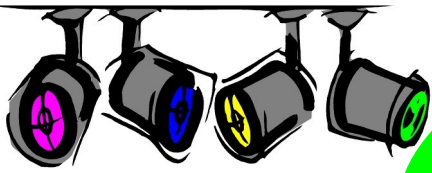

As always I am looking forward to another exciting and fortnight at Tingha Public School.

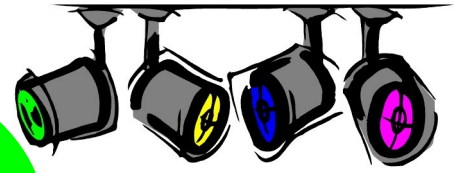

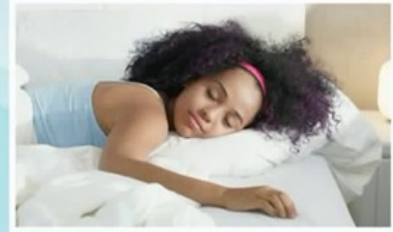
HOW MUCH SLEEP SHOULD CHILDREN GET?
