Semester One Reports and Parent Interviews

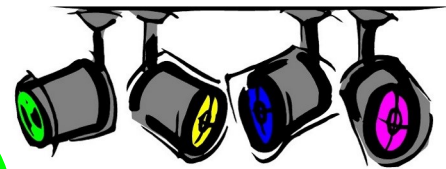
Our Semester One reports will be issued on Monday 27th June as part of our parent teacher interviews. A booking sheet for interviews times will be sent home next week.

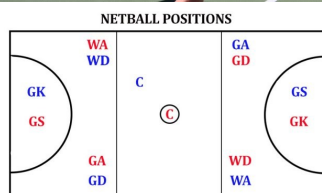
As always, I am looking forward to another exciting fortnight at Tingha Public School.

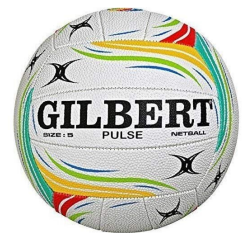
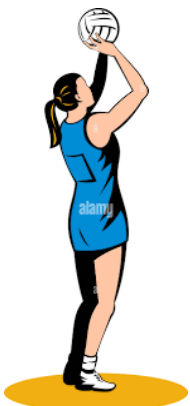

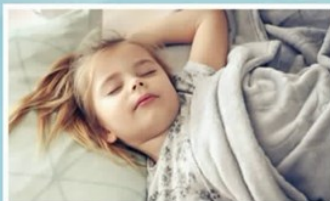
A day here or there doesn't seem like much, but...
